A nurse is reinforcing teaching with a client who has burn injuries to his trunk about what to expect from the prescribed hydrotherapy. Which of the following statements by the client indicates an understanding of the teaching? - CORRECT ANSWER - "I will be on a special shower table."•

A nurse is reinforcing teaching with a client who has a large wound healing by secondary intention. The nurse should instruct the client that which of the following nutrients promotes wound healing? - CORRECT ANSWER - Vitamin C (A diet high in protein and Vitamin C is recommended)

A nurse is reinforcing teaching with a client who is wheelchair-bound and his caregiver about ways to reduce the risk of pressure ulcer formation. Which of the following instructions should the nurse include? - CORRECT ANSWER - "Shift your weight in the wheelchair every 15 minutes."•

Squamous cell carcinoma (SCC) - CORRECT ANSWER - skin cancer that begins in the epidermis but may grow into deeper tissue; does not generally metastasize to other areas of the body
