

A not withhold oxygen or their supportive care - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Your patient has cancer and is obviously near death. A valid dnr is valid you should

assist respiration with bvm - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -your patient is cardiac arrest. After administering a shock and two minutes of cpr, you detect a faint pulse. Vital signs are bp 90/50 p58 r6

chf - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Your patient is complaining of shortness of breath. Vital signs are bp 188/110 p120 r 32 and shallow. Lung sounds include crackles or bubbling sounds. You should suspect

Assess the patient as you normally would - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Your patient is on a home ventilator. While performing your assessment, you should

assess the patient's breathing and pulse - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Your patient is unconscious. The nurse states on scene "the patient is bradycardia, please attach your AED and transfer rapidly. What should you do?

foreign body obstruction - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Your patient was eating when he suddenly grasped his throat. He is cannot speak or cough. You should suspect

ask partner to pull over - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -You are transporting a 44 yr old male complaining of chest pain when he becomes pulseless and apneic. You should

Stop vehicle, confirm pulselessness , apply an AED and shock if necessary - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -You are transporting a patient with chest discomfort.
