Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) = colloquially known as "**Mounties**" and internally as "**The Force**" = is the national police force of Canada and one of the most recognized of its kind in the world being a national, federal, provincial and municipal policing body. It is founded in 1920 by the Merger of Royal Northwest Mounted Police (1873) with the Dominion Police (1868).
