Condition for Germination

- Water- Water hydrates the tissues of the seed and is needed for enzymatic hydrolysis so that the germinated seed can respire.
- Oxygen- Oxygen is used by the germinated seed to conduct aerobic respiration.
- Temperature- Suitable temperature is needed for respiration and metabolic enzymes to work.

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
