What does it look like?	Process of extracting natural resources. Natural Resources Examples: gold, diamonds, water, oil, farming, fishing. Extracting- going and getting them, harvesting them Any country can extract their natural resource	Adding value natural resources and creating products. Example: Shaping/cutting the diamonds to create something people will buy.	Providing professional services and the service required to distribute the products. Example: Stores/people who sell diamonds.	Process of STUDYING product research and improving on its production. Example: Innovations in diamond cutting/shaping, find where diamonds are located.
Skills &/or Education Salary/Pay	- No formal education is required. - Example: Any person can find diamonds if taken to the right location	- On the job training is required for individual work in factories to develop the products.	- Doctors and waitress give a service, business sell products & their pay varies dependent on skill level	- Most have middle – high skill level to study the product, do industry research.
