Summary

- Lining epithelia may be classified according to the number of layers, cell shape and surface specialisations and which reflects their function.
- Glandular epithelia may be exocrine or endocrine.
- Exocrine glands may be classified according to nature of secretory units and ducts.
- Epithelia have complex membrane specialisations which help bind cells together and form a selective barrier.
