B. Apothecaries' and Avoirdupois System

- One of the oldest systems of measurement
- There are still some medications which have been used for many years which are customarily written using this system
examples are:

Morphine sulfate

Atropine sulfate

Codeine

Sodium Phenobarbital

Aspirin

Avoirdupois Measure of Weight

1 g	15. 432 gr
1 kg	2.20 lb (avoir)
1 g	0.065 g or 65 mg
1 oz	28.35 g
1 dram	31.1 g
1 lb (avoir.)	454 g
1 lb (apoth)	373.2 g
1 oz	437.5 gr

NOTE:

Apothecaries' and Avoirdupois System share some similar units of measurement but, they have different values
