

↓ = Conjunction (Hypotactical)

→ = Conjunction (Paratactical)

o-x = Implicit subject

x-▲ = Object predicate (Accusative)

ox(x in o) = Subject predicate (Nominative) ("was a good decision", "was" is a verbal link, and "a good decision" is like a word for itself, therefore ox.

### Examples from the tuition:

He gives the slave a beating.

x o Dat. ▲

The husband's wife is neat.

Gen x o ox

The girl is beautiful.

x o ▲

The car is fast.

x o ▲

He calls her wonderful.

x o x-▲

(x-triangle is used, when the adjective(often accusative object) stands in direct connection with the substantive(often the subject).

She has a horse.

x o

They have tossed the money away.

x o triangle x-▲

There is a cat on the road.
