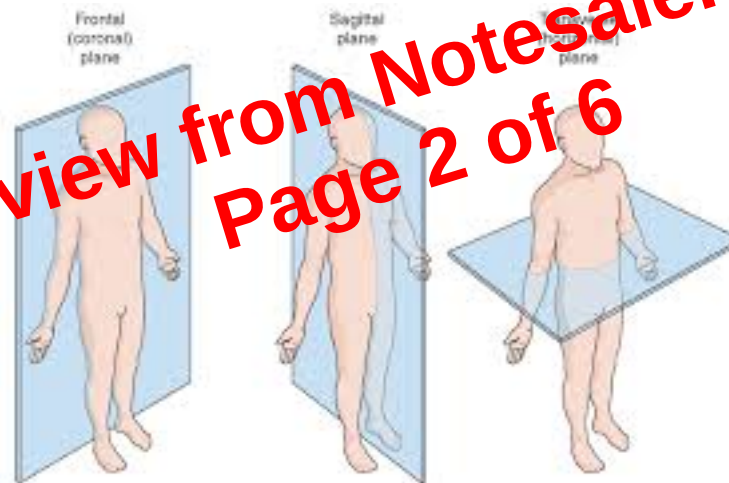


7. List the terms used in describing locations of structures and relative location of structures when in the anatomical position.

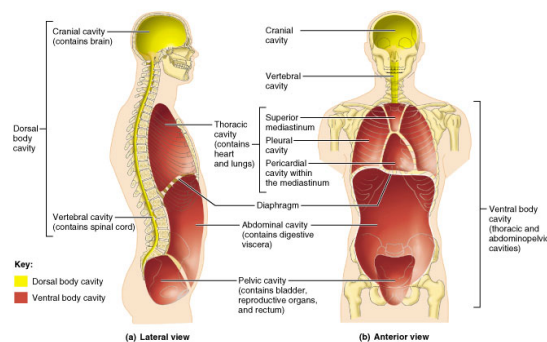
- a. Anterior- in front of; toward front surface
- b. Posterior-in back of; toward the back surface
- c. Dorsal- at the back side of the body
- d. Ventral- at the belly side of the body
- e. Superior- toward the head or above
- f. Inferior- toward the feet or below
- g. Cranial- at the head end
- h. Caudal- at the rear or tail end
- i. Medial- toward the midline
- j. Lateral- away from midline
- k. Proximal – closest to point of attachment
- l. Distal- furthest from point of attachment
- m. Superficial- on the surface
- n. Deep- on the inside

8. Define frontal (coronal), transverse, sagittal (both median and parasagittal) and oblique planes.

- a. Oblique plane- diagonal cuts along either horizontal or vertical planes
