

Terms & Conditions

1. The engagement is purely on Contract Basis for the period up to 31.03.2017 or till such time the post is filled up on regular basis or till further orders whichever is earlier.
2. The engagement can be terminated at any time without assigning any reason.
3. The contract will stand automatically terminated after 31.03.2017 unless the same is further extended in writing.
4. The applicant will be entitled to one causal leave in a month and will not be entitled to any other kind of leave.
5. The applicant will be entitled to get benefit of Provident Fund only as per existing rule and the applicant will not be entitled to get benefit of Pension, Gratuity, Bonus, Medical Attendance/Treatment, seniority, T.A, D.A, or any other benefit, which are admissible to the Municipal Employee/Govt. Servants, appointed on regular/adhoc basis.
6. The applicant will not be granted any claim/right for regular/adhoc appointment to the post or any other benefit.
7. The engagement carries with it the liability to serve in any part of the area of SDMC.
8. The candidate will be required to submit a Medical Fitness Certificate from an MBBS Doctor.
9. The applicant will not be entitled to any T.A for taking on the assignment.
10. Other conditions of Contractual service will be governed by relevant rules orders, issued from time to time.
11. If any irregularities/discrepancies are noticed, applicant will be liable for action under the provisions of Act/Rules/Codes etc. pending dis-engagement of the Contractual service in SDMC.
12. If any irregularities/discrepancies are noticed, the contract will be immediately terminated and the Contractual appointee will be liable for action under the applicable provisions of Rules codes Act etc.
13. The candidate should not have been convicted by any court and not booked under I.P.C. There should be no criminal case pending against him at the time of entering into contract.
14. The candidate should not have been removed/dismissed from service by his previous employers due to any misconduct/embezzlement.
15. A Contract Agreement on Non-judicial stamp Paper of Rs. 100/- shall be submitted by the applicant, duly attested by the Notary Public.
16. In case the offer of Engagement is acceptable to the applicant on the above mentioned terms and conditions he/she should give his/her acceptance to the undersigned by within ten days of issuing offer of Engagement letter, failing which, the offer of Engagement shall stand cancelled without further notice.
17. The applicant shall bring the Certificate/Documents (in original) alongwith two recent passport size photographs on reporting date and after verification he/she shall have to enter into agreement on the above terms and conditions for Contractual Engagement.
