

Example - a mule is produced by a male dokey and a female horse, it has 63 chromosomes which is a mixture of horse's 64 and the donkey's 62. This different structure and number usually prevents the chromosomes from pairing up properly to create a successful embryos, making it infertile.

Hybrid breakdown: if the hybrid results to be fertile, the hybrid population might disappear along time as from one generation to the next they may result weaker, less fertile, etc.
