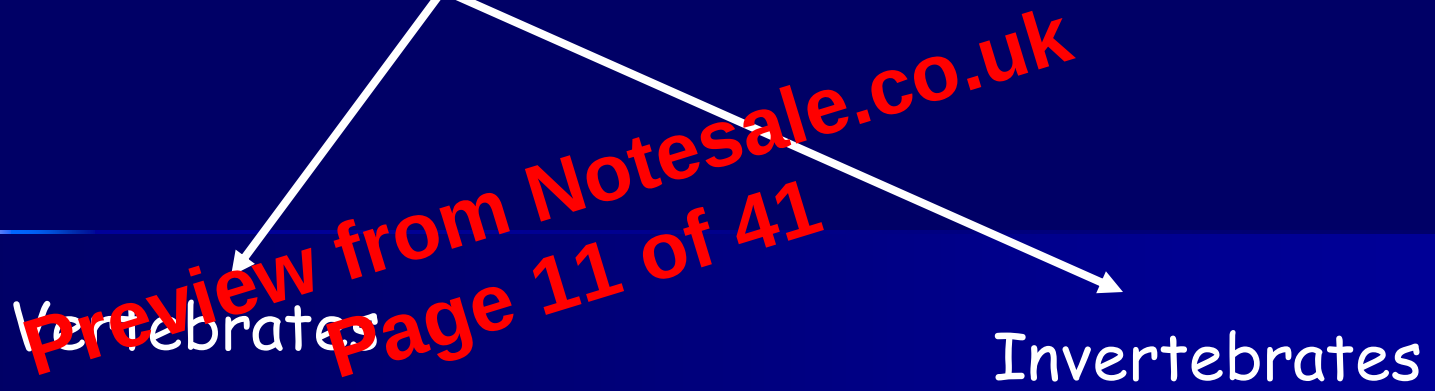

Fungi

- Can be multicellular or unicellular
- Never contain chloroplasts
- The main body of most fungi is made up of fine, branching, usually colourless threads called hyphae.
- Each fungus will have vast numbers of these hyphae, all intertwining to make up a tangled web called the mycelium
- Feed by absorbing nutrients from dead or living material: digestion takes place outside the organism (saprotrophic nutrition) by secreting extra cellular enzymes.
- Reproduce by forming spores
- Cell walls are made of chitin
- May store carbohydrate as glycogen
