IDIOMS

1. AT THE ELEVENTH HOUR

At the last minute: almost too late.

EXAMPLES

I thought I was gonna be late for school but I arrived at the eleventh hour.

2. BAD-MOUTH

Say unkind, unflattering, embarassing and untrue things about someone.

i. The furious player began to Bad-mouth his condition. 3. ELBOW GREASE TO OF Hard CAN PLES

The utilities need a bit more <u>elbow grease</u> to get these walls really clean.

4. BITE OFF MORE THAN ONE CAN CHEW

Take responsibility for more than one can manage. **EXAMPLES**

i. You cannot bite off more than one can chew. Let someone else organize The pary for you.

5. FAR-FETCHED

Difficult to accept; Difficult to believe.

EXAMPLES

I love this TV series but I cant help to think that this far-fetched final episode lets the side down a bit.
