

IDIOMS

1. AT THE ELEVENTH HOUR

At the last minute;almost too late.

3. ELBOW GREASE

EXAMPLES

- i. The utilities need a bit more elbow grease to get these walls really clean.

4. BITE OFF MORE THAN ONE CAN CHEW

Take responsibility for more than one can manage.

EXAMPLES

- i. You cannot bite off more than one can chew. Let someone else organize
The party for you.

5. FAR-FETCHED

Difficult to accept;Difficult to believe.

EXAMPLES

- i. I love this TV series but I cant help to think that this far-fetched final episode lets
the side down a bit.
