  - determined in womb
- o congenital adrenal hyperplasia
- choice of play
  - certain activities activate certain hormones
- Organizational influences
  - sex linked hormones affect development prenatally or during aly
- Activity influence
  - environment influences affect activation of hormones

- ingroup bias
  - we identify w/ people of the same gender, usually

## Academic Achievement btw Genders

- Biological influences
- Brain differences
- Environment contributes to it
  - girls more encouraged in some studies, boys encouraged more in others
- Effect of androgens
  - secreted in womb
  - androgenized females= have more masculine personality traits
- Males have more disabilities
  - small y chromosome- less room, more affected by bio diseases
- Parental Influences
  - mothers talk more to girls than boys
  - more talking leads to faster language development
  - parents expectations lead to domain specific development
  - if one has all boys or all girls, not as much gender stereotyping
    - more when you have both girls and boys
- Teacher influences
  - women as science teachers
  - higher achievement in boys than girls
