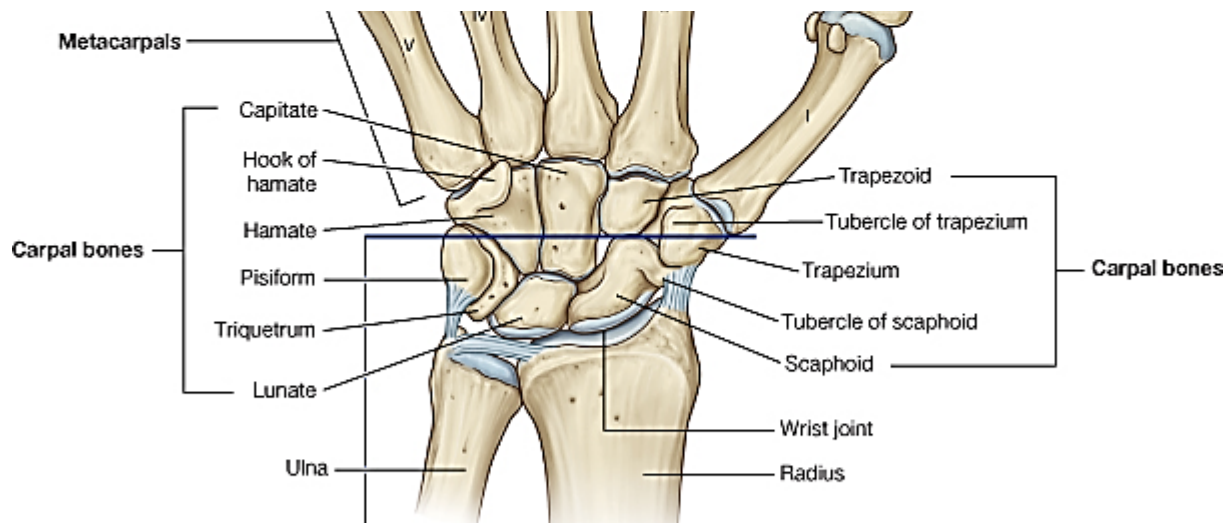


Carpal Bones

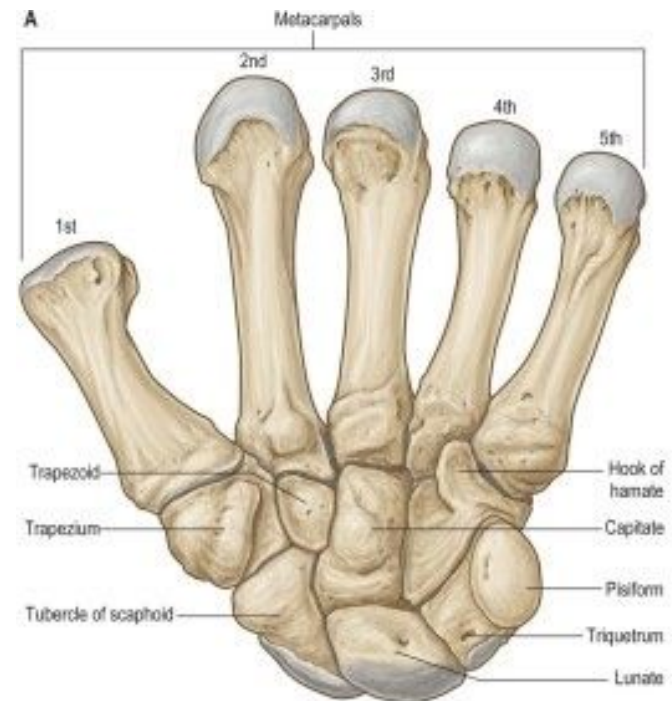
- Proximal row:

- the boat-shaped **scaphoid**;
- the **lunate**, which has a 'crescent shape';
- the three-sided **triquetrum** bone;
- the pea-shaped **pisiform**

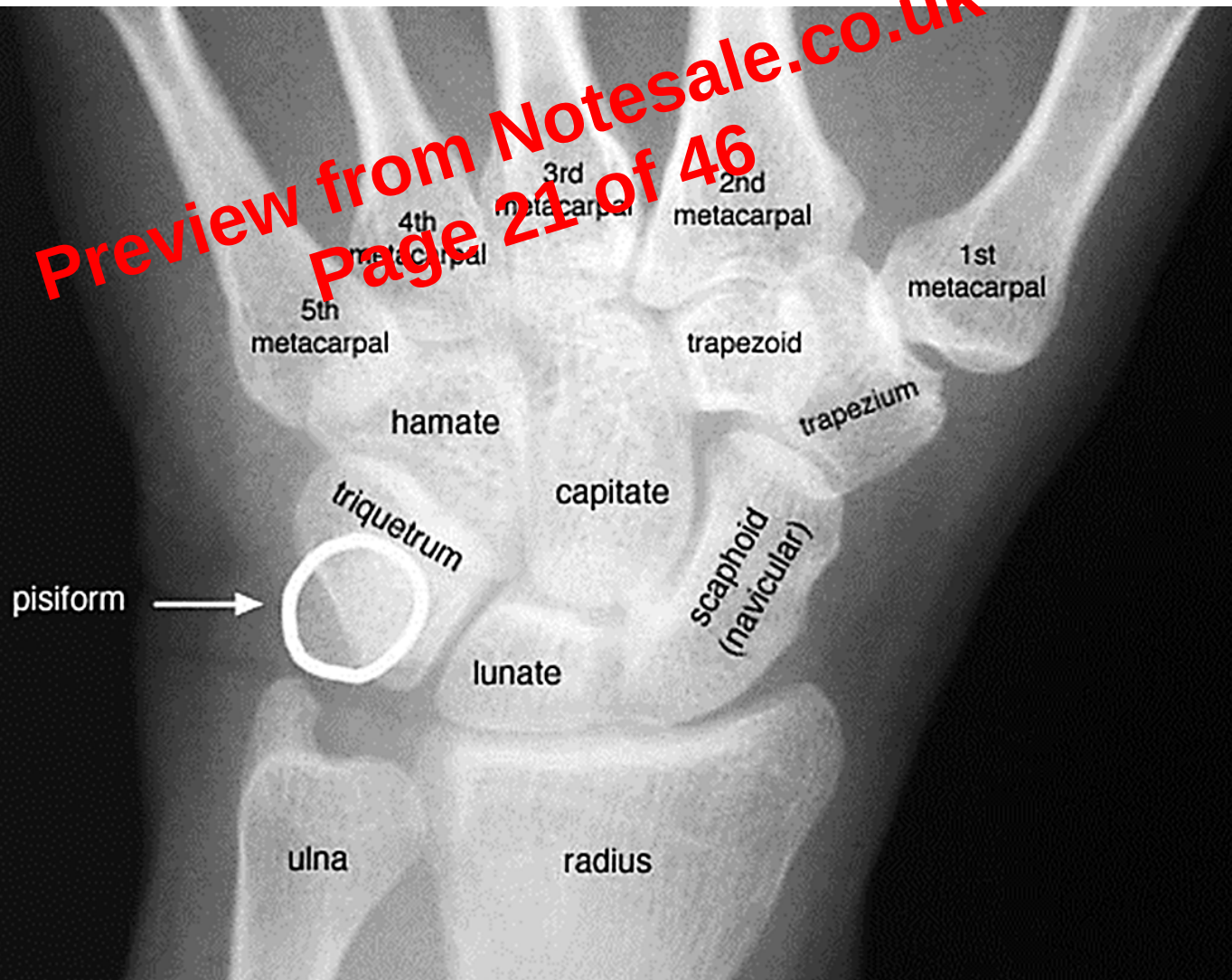


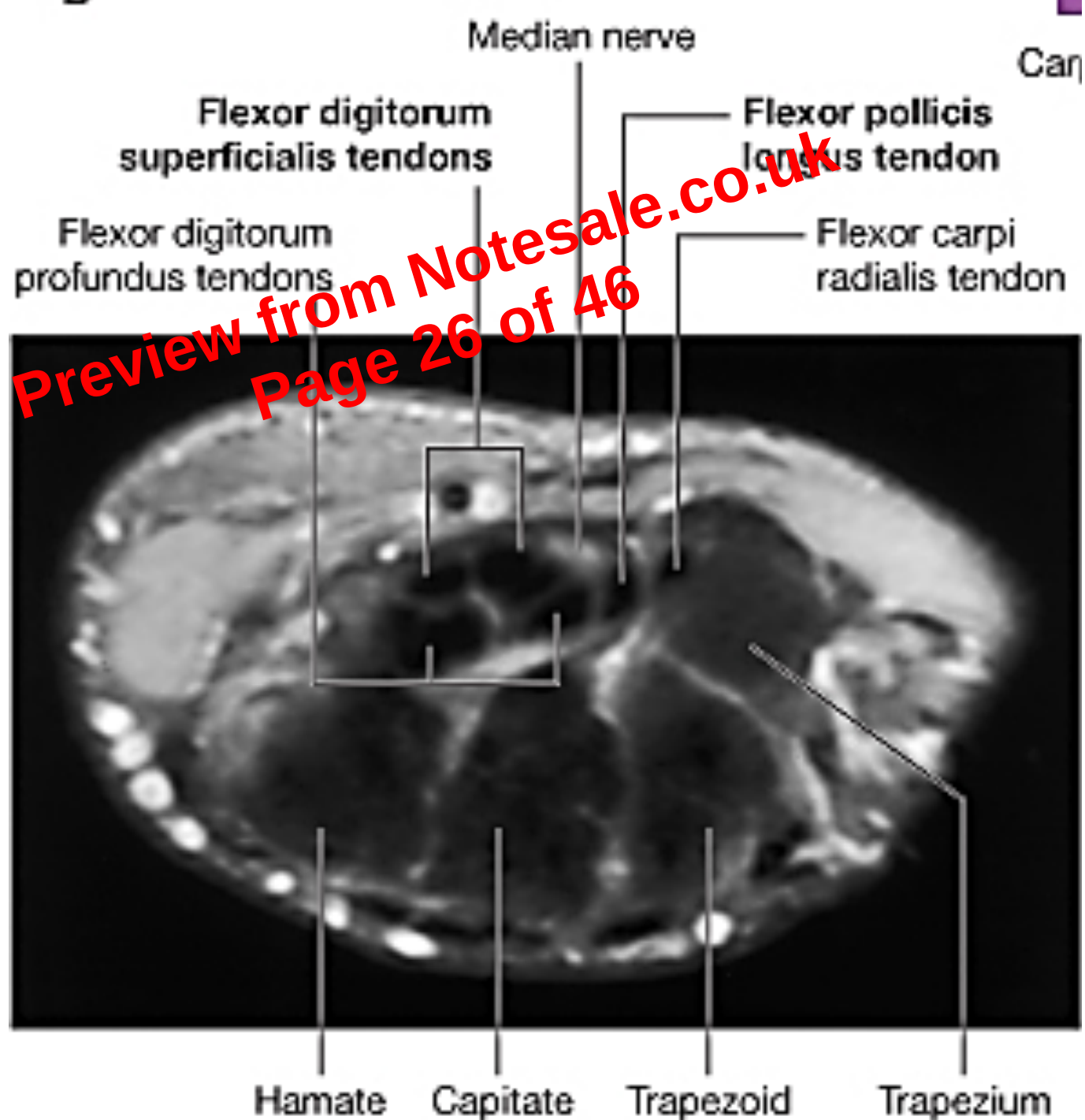
Metacarpal Bones

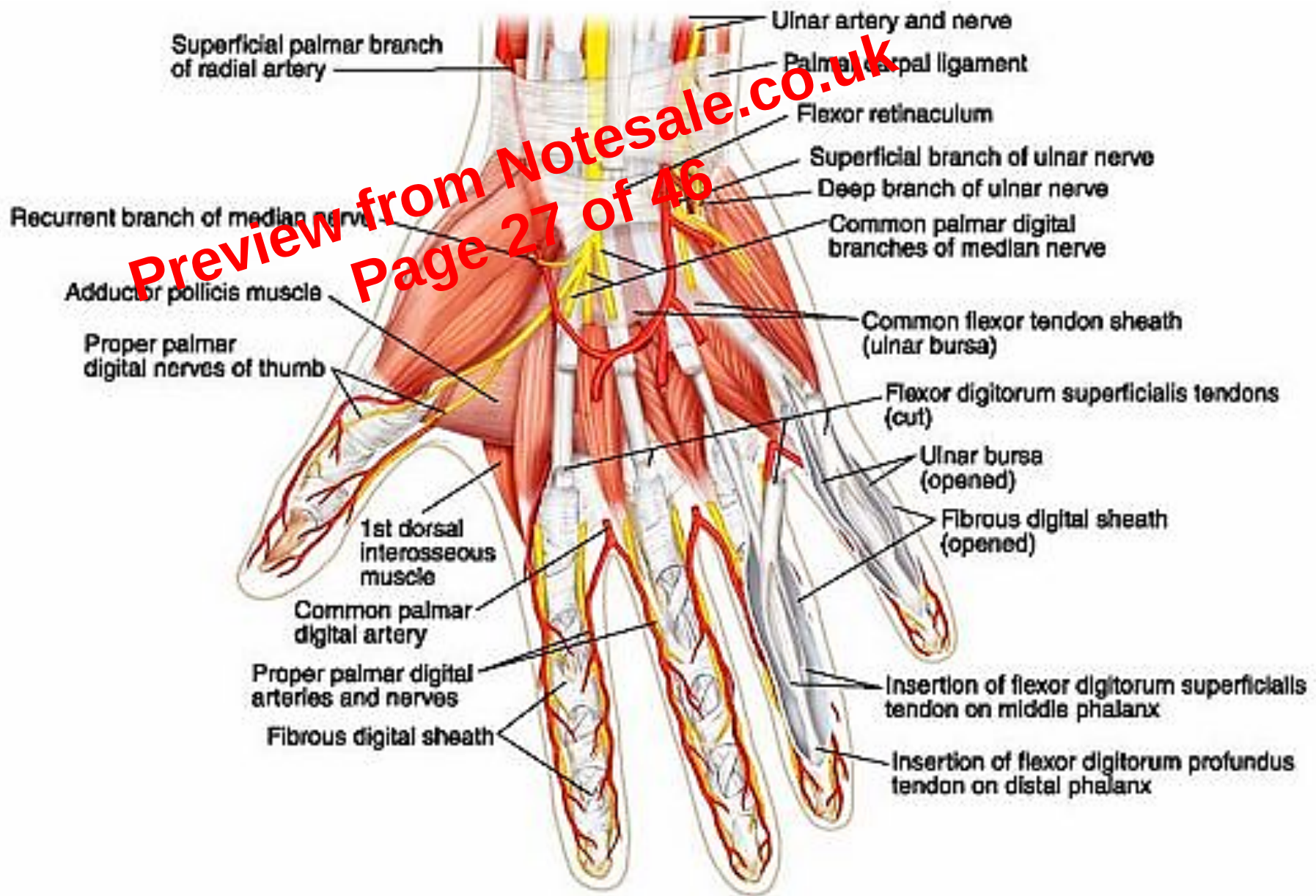
- Each of the five metacarpal bones is related to one digit
- Each metacarpal consists of a **base**, a **shaft** (**body**), and distally, a **head**



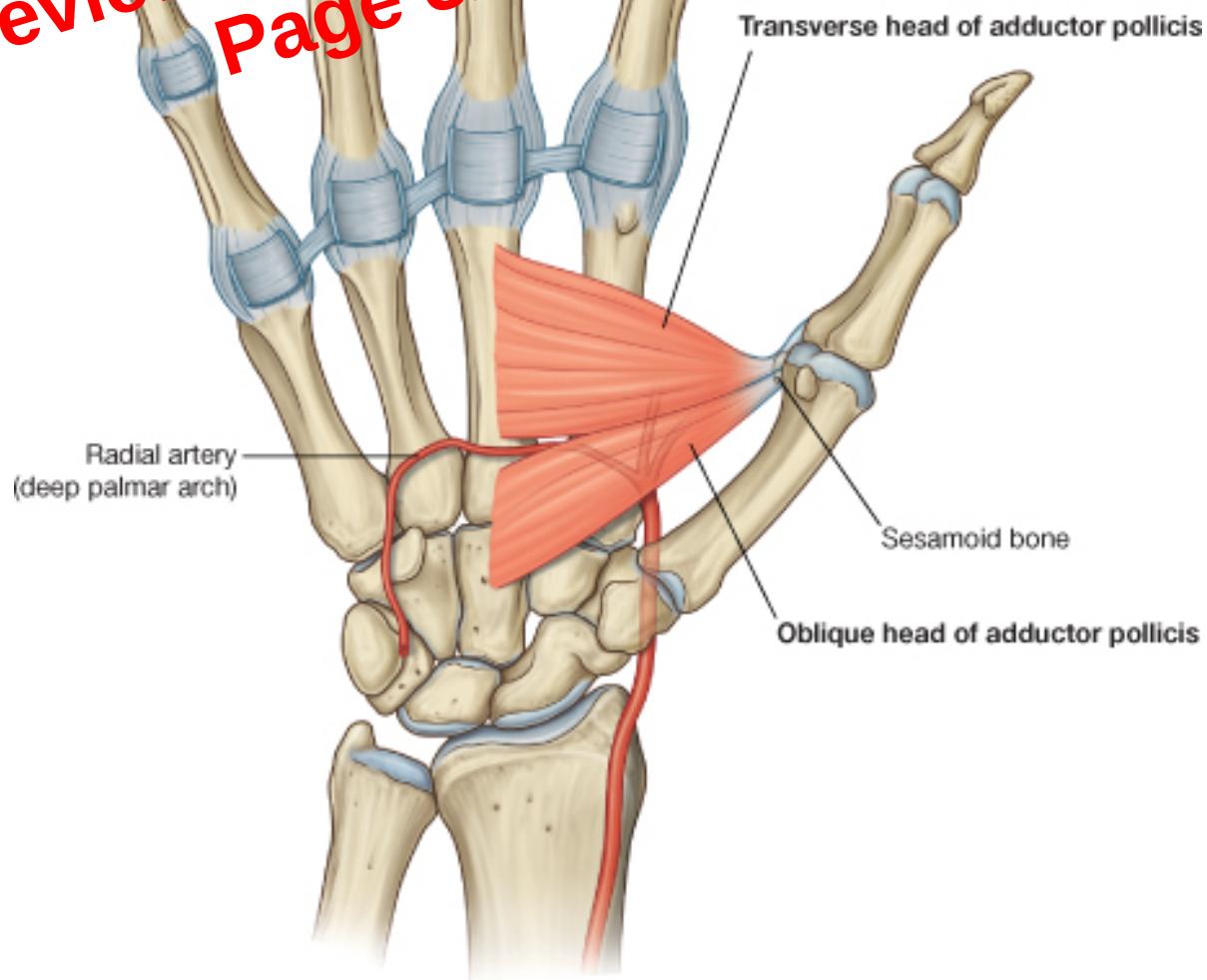

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- Subclavian artery becomes the axillary artery as it crosses the lateral margin of 1st rib and enters the axilla
 - Axillary vein becomes the subclavian vein as it passes over the lateral margin of 1st rib and leaves the axilla to enter the neck
 - As they pass over 1st rib, the vein and artery are separated by the insertion of the anterior scalene muscle
