

  - the pea-shaped pisiform







• Each of the five metatarpal bones is related to one of the page


Each metacarpal consists of a base, a shaft


(**body**), and distally, a **head** 











- Subclavian artery peroffes the axillary artery as itterbssep 1996 lateral margin of 1st rib and enters the axilla
- Axillary vein becomes the subclavian vein as it passes over the lateral margin of 1st rib and leaves the axilla to enter the neck
- As they pass over 1<sup>st</sup> rib, the vein and artery are separated by the insertion of the anterior scalene muscle
