Differences between discontinuous and continuous variations

Discontinuous variation	continuous variation

When there is variation in a population of organisms, the survival advantage is increased as the organisms are more resistant to changes in the environment. A population of organisms can be wiped out by environmental conditions, diseases, competition and parasitism. in addition, natural selection acts on variations in a species of organisms so that the organisms that can adapt to the condition of the environment will survive and reproduce to pass on the favourable traits to the next generation.
